REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS

Law Enforcement Officer of the Year

Firefighter of the Year

Citizen of the Year

LEO (Law Enforcement Officer of the Year):

Each Post should seek a candidate to be submitted as their representative from the Post to the District. The District Chairman should set a dead line date: Once that date arrives the District Chairman should convene a Selection Committee to choose "one" candidate from those submitted by the Post. When that take's place the District Chairman signs off on the selectee and submits him or her to me at my home address. The package must be post marked before March 1st, not on March 1st... I will convene a selection committee and choose the Department representative.

Firefighter of the Year:

The only difference between this award and LEO is the Firefighter may be an EMS, however they must be a qualified Firefighter as well...

Citizen of the Year:

The only difference between this award and LEO and Firefighter is the District Selectee must not be paid for what they do: going above the line of duty holds true for the other awards; going above and beyond the normal routine of life is the key for a citizen.

I'm open to all questions: Two very important things to remember: The packages must be post marked prior to March 1st. The dead line to me is March 1st or post marked BEFORE March 1st. And the District selectee's package must be signed by the District Chairman for that award...
